The Delta Dental of Oklahoma Oral Health Foundation has announced its initial 32 statewide grants for 2015. Selected through a board-reviewed application process, the foundation allocated more than \$1.4 million to fund free and low-cost dental clinics, dental education programs and various oral health initiatives.
