# **RAM Oklahoma Delivers Care and Smiles**

Starting junior high is tough. When you have a chipped front tooth, it's even tougher. Twelveyear-old Alexis knows just how that feels. And now, thanks to volunteer dental professionals, she has a beautiful, restored smile!

Alexis is one of more than 1,500 Oklahomans who received free dental, vision and medical services at the Remote Area Medical (RAM) Oklahoma event held at the state

fairgrounds August 25th and 26th. Volunteer dental professionals served 1,016 dental patients with 1,325 extractions, 243 fillings and 153 cleanings.

Prior to the event, Delta Dental of Oklahoma employees assembled 1,500 brush kits for RAM patients. At the clinic, DDOK employees teamed up with dental hygiene and assisting students to provide the patients with important education and resources for future care.

# OkMOM Named 2012 Community Health Champion

The Oklahoma Mission of Mercy (OkMOM) has been named the "Community Health Champion" in the Champions of Health awards. The Champions of Health program celebrates people and organizations that are making a positive impact on the health of our state through innovative programs.

OkMOM, a free dental clinic that aims to meet the patient's immediate dental needs, focuses on improving not only oral health but overall health. Since 2010, Delta Dental of Oklahoma Oral Health Foundation has co-sponsored the event with Oklahoma Dental Association and Oklahoma Dental Foundation by providing \$350,000 in funding. Each year, dozens of DDOK employees look forward to helping plan the event and volunteering during the clinic.

To date, the three OkMOM clinics have treated 5,739 patients, resulting in over \$3 million worth of donated dental services!

"The secret to the ongoing success of OkMOM is the willingness of



Oklahoma's dental professionals to volunteer to provide the dental care itself, even when that means traveling across the state," said John Gladden, DDOK president and CEO. "Nothing happens without them."
